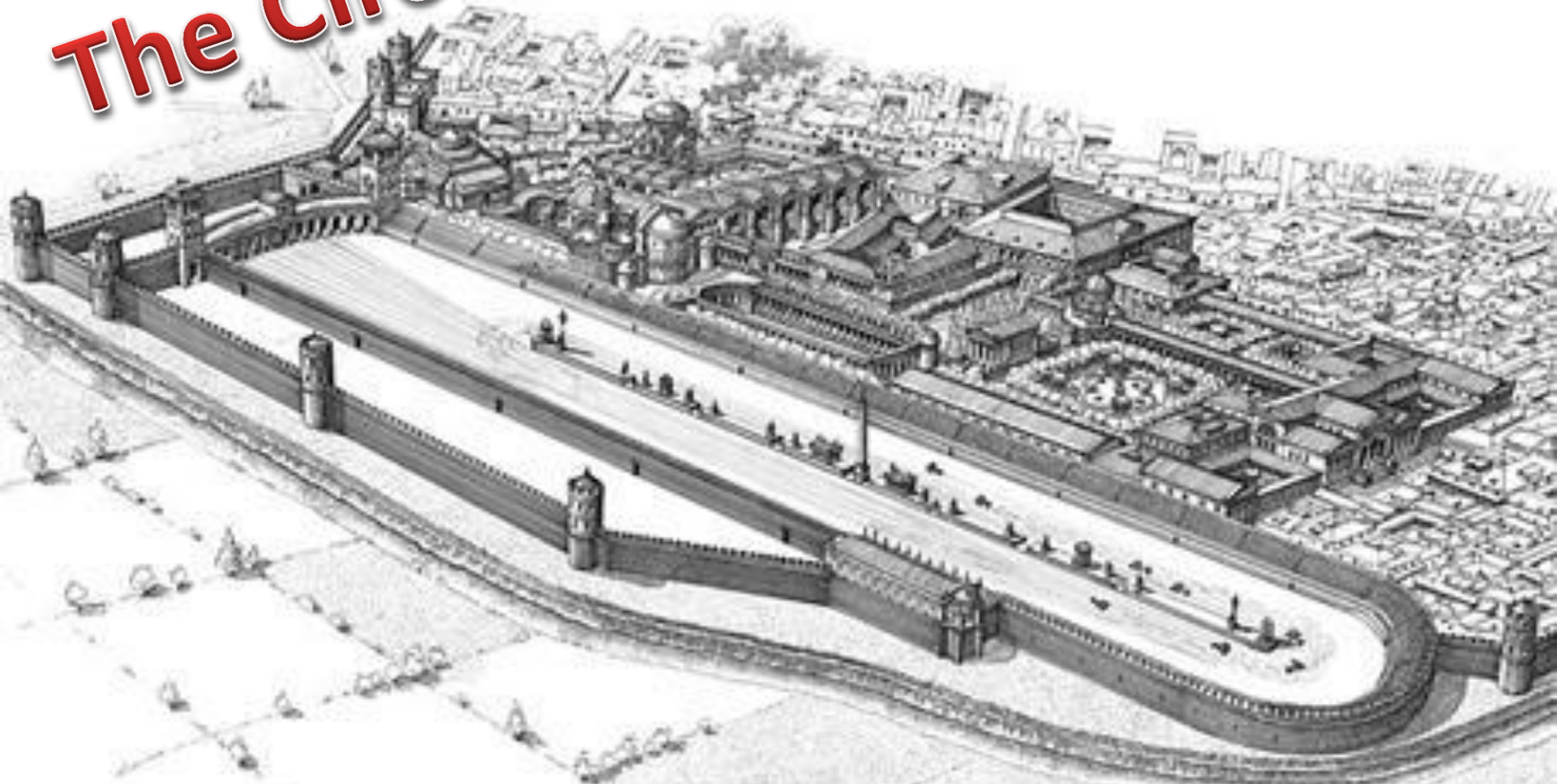
Apollo



Apollo and Vesta were two deities of art, entertainment and wealth of the city and their chapells were often put in play areas as the circus.



The Circus



The Circus extends from the square Tresca to the Cathedral. With its elongated shape remains undeveloped, currently corresponds to the area of the municipal garden and the surrounding area.




-The necropolis are located along the areas to Potenza and Porta Napoli (south). In the necropolis of Porta Napoli various findings testify the wealth level achieved in the past.



In "potenza" an important discovery was an epigraphic text on city life





In places Marane where is the current Casino Pantano. Remains of Roman masonry have been found long considered belonging to a residence of Ovidio



The temple dedicated to *Jupiter* (according to an epigraphic documentation at the moment disappeared), was in the area that today is the church of *S. Maria della Tomba*
